**Venue**

The Tallebudgera Active Recreation Centre  
1525 Gold Coast Hwy, North Palm Beach, Gold Coast, Queensland



All the above activities are at the same venue and accommodation is also available at this venue. The accommodation is in cabins/dormitory style (please see the link below to see what it looks like):

The accommodation is only available for a minimum of two nights stay at the following rates:

<b>Friday, 1 October</b>	\$16 per person
<b>Saturday, 2 October</b>	\$16 per person
<b>Linen for the weekend</b>	<u>\$9.90 per person</u>
<b>TOTAL</b>	<b>\$39.90 per person in total for the 2 nights</b>



## Meals

For those using the above accommodation, meals are available as follows:

Friday Dinner and Supper	\$8 per person
Saturday Breakfast and Morning Tea	\$8 per person
Saturday Lunch and Afternoon Tea	\$8 per person
Saturday Dinner and Supper	\$8 per person
Sunday Breakfast and Morning Tea	<u>\$8 per person</u>
<b>TOTAL for 5 meals</b>	<b>\$40 per person</b>



In other words, a total of \$79.90 per person for two nights' accommodation and 5 meals!  
For those not staying at the venue, an additional charge of \$2.94 per meal applies.

All bookings for the above accommodation must please be made through the QAWA because the Recreation Centre does not deal with individual bookings. The bookings are on a first-come first-served basis and must be accompanied by a 20% deposit. It would be appreciated if all State Associations could please co-ordinate this for their State and provide the QAWA with the details of those wanting to make use of this accommodation by **no later than 30 July 2010**. The QAWA will then make the booking on your behalf. Please remember that they cannot reserve any space for us, so there is no guarantee that it will be available. Therefore, the sooner you can provide the QAWA with your numbers, the better the chance that we could secure the booking for you.

For those not wanting to make use of this accommodation, there are of course hundreds of other facilities on the Gold Coast.

## Transportation

For those flying, the best option is to fly directly to Coolangatta Airport. From there the City Council buses run directly to the above competition and accommodation venue. These buses are also available to take you back to the airport on Sunday.
