QUOTA BY NOC
Maximum five (5) athletes by NOC, that is: two (2) men in freestyle, two (2) men in Greco-Roman, and one (1) woman.

ATHLETES' ELIGIBILITY
To be allowed to take part in the 2010 Youth Olympic Games, the athletes will have to be born between January 1 st , 1993 and December 31 st , 1994.
The athletes will also have to be members of a National Federation affiliated to FILA and have a valid FILA licence for 2010.

B. Qualification system

PERFORMANCE AND CONTINENTAL REPRESENTATION			
FILA will organise a qualification tournament on each continent in May 2010.			
The best ranked wrestlers in each qualification tournament will be qualified according to the following criteria :

Universality places

The eligibility criteria are the same as the ones described above. In order to guarantee the ideal number of eight (8) wrestlers per category (to comply with the FILA direct elimination system), a maximum of one (1) or two (2) wrestlers per style will be chosen.

REPRESENTATION OF THE HOST COUNTRY

Two (2) qualification places (one man and one woman) will be allocated to the host country to complete the ideal number of eight (8) wrestlers per style.

C. Reallocation of the unused places

UNUSED PLACES IN THE IF QUOTA

In the event of unused places, the athlete ranked next in the category concerned of the continental qualification tournament will be qualified. The place will have to remain in the continent concerned. If no athlete of the same continent is eligible, the place will be reallocated as part of the universality quota.

UNUSED PLACES IN THE HOST COUNTRY QUOTA

Any unused place by the host country will be reallocated as part of the universality quota.

UNUSED UNIVERSALITY PLACES

The unused universality places will be reallocated to the NOC that took part in the continental qualification tournaments but did not manage to qualify any wrestler in order to reach the ideal number of eight (8) wrestlers per category.

The reallocation per continent will be done according to the following order: 1 – Africa, 2 – Oceania, 3 – Asia, 4 – America and 5 – Europe.
