COMPETITION RULES and Conditions of Entry:

1. All wrestlers are only eligible to compete if they are a member of a Constituent Association, irrespective of whether their relevant Wrestling Club is a member of a Constituent Association of Wrestling Australia Inc.
2. **All competitors are required to be a financial member of their State Association AND Wrestling Australia Inc.**
3. All competitors are responsible for their own medical and physical fitness to wrestle and understand that the nature of the sport of wrestling involves some physical risks that can result in serious injury or death. It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure they are free of skin lesions or allergies and is fit to compete.
4. Competition will be conducted in accordance with **UWW Rules**; draw will use a modified pairing system.
5. Weight Categories are set to the current **USA male junior weight categories**. All competitors must make weight within these categories.
6. Proof of Age: The Australian wrestlers State President or Secretary to certify that the wrestler is 14 -19 years old at the date of the Competition
7. Competitors that are **under 18 years of age must** have the application form duly signed by their parent/guardian.
8. The wrestler, coach and supporters agree to comply with the Wrestling Australia Inc. code of conduct during this competition.
9. The Australian Sports Drug Agency (ASADA) may conduct Drug Testing during the competition. ASADA may also conduct out of competition testing at any time. If requested by ASADA to undergo drug testing, the competitor must comply with the request. For more information on ASADA Drug Testing please contact ASADA at P.O. 2016 DownUnder Sports Wrestling Competition Schedule:

WQ Inc. will send the list of Australian competitors the competition organizer on the 8th July 2016. Weigh-in cards will be given to coaches prior to weigh-in.

Thursday, July 14th, 2016 @ 12:30pm

Beach Wrestling (King of the Mat). Surfers Paradise Beach.

Wrestlers are divided into groups from weigh-in cards (last year we had five groups.) The wrestlers wrestle on the beach until one wrestler is 3 points ahead. A wrestler will score one point when his opponent is pushed out of the ring, or any part of opponent's body touches the sand. Three will be scored by scoring a normal 3 point move on your opponent. This is more of a fun competition rather than a competitive event. The competitors will wear swim suits or shorts and t-shirts.

Wrestlers and team managers are to be in attendance at this time! Draw numbers will be assigned by the computer and placed on the weigh-in cards prior to weigh-in. A team may weigh in more than one wrestler at the same weight.

Teams Event:

- Teams who have two or more wrestlers at every weight (or almost every weight) may enter two teams.
- Teams who have extra wrestlers at only a few weights may combine these wrestlers to form another team.
- Individual weigh in cards will be used. These cards will be used to place wrestlers in both tournaments.

Special Weigh-in (Australians): Saturday, July 16th at 8:00am (closes when last wrestler is weighed) at All-Saints Anglican School. The draw will be done prior to this special weigh-in. **You will be forfeited from the individual competition if you do not make your nominated weight.** If you are attending the special weigh-in on Saturday, WQ Inc. must be notified **before** Friday, July 15th, 2016 so they can nominate you at the normal weigh-in.

The Individual Tournament begins at 11 AM on three mats. Wrestling will be done by weight classes. Order of weights will be posted as larger weight classes will wrestle first.

6pm coaches draw for dual teams event at the Mantra Sun City

In the dual team tournament the teams will be drawn from the pool of all the wrestlers. The wrestlers will be sorted into weight categories and the coach of each team will draw a wrestler from each weight category. Every wrestler will be put in a team. An extra team will be formed to accommodate wrestlers that were not in the original draw. This method of selecting the teams is designed to make the competition a more even playing field. In the Individual competition the wrestler will have his own coach and in the dual team's competition will have the benefit of new perspective from another coach
